Mellon 5+1 Fellowships at the Notre Dame Global Gateways

SUMMARY: Notre Dame International invites applications from 5+1 postdoctoral fellow to take up residence at one of the university's Global Gateways in London or Rome for a semester or full academic year in 2017-2018. Fellows should propose a research project they plan to undertake during the year and a rationale for pursuing this project at a particular Gateway. To discharge their service obligation, fellows may teach a course or courses at the Gateway (subject to program needs) or they may work with Notre Dame students on a more informal basis, advising research projects, for example; they may also work to support research projects at the Gateways and/or they may seek teaching or internships with local partner institutions. Duties and hours will be worked out on a case by case basis.

Dates: August 2017-May 2018, although a single semester placement may be possible.

Time Commitment: Negotiable, but a minimum of 15 hours per week and a maximum of 35.

Compensation: Fellows will be provided accommodations or a stipend supplement to help offset the cost of living abroad. Each fellow will be provided with one round-trip ticket from the US to the Gateway city.
